Drawings of KG kids in Art class:

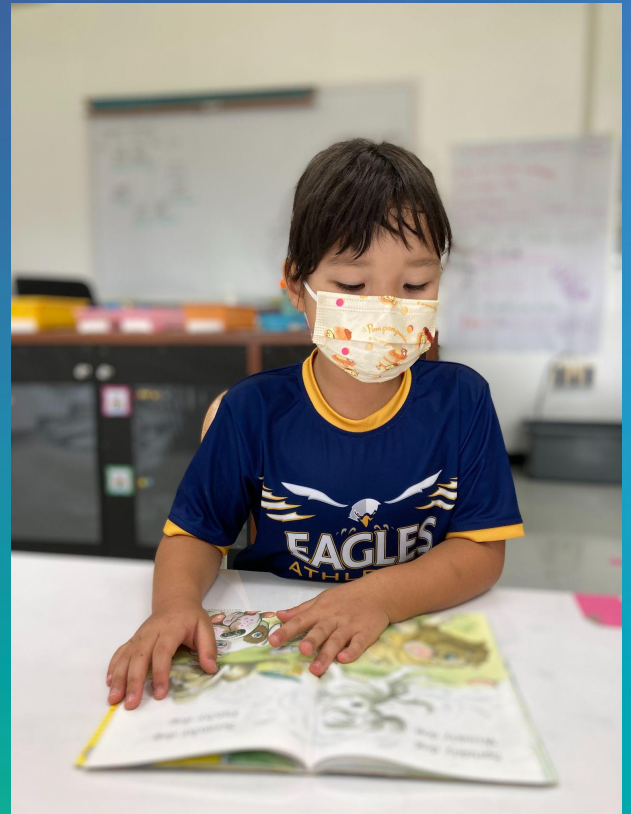

Elementary School G1-G2

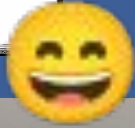


In Grade 1 and 2, the students started a habit of getting their library books out and reading during their school day. Students borrowed one book of their choice and one teacher-recommended book.

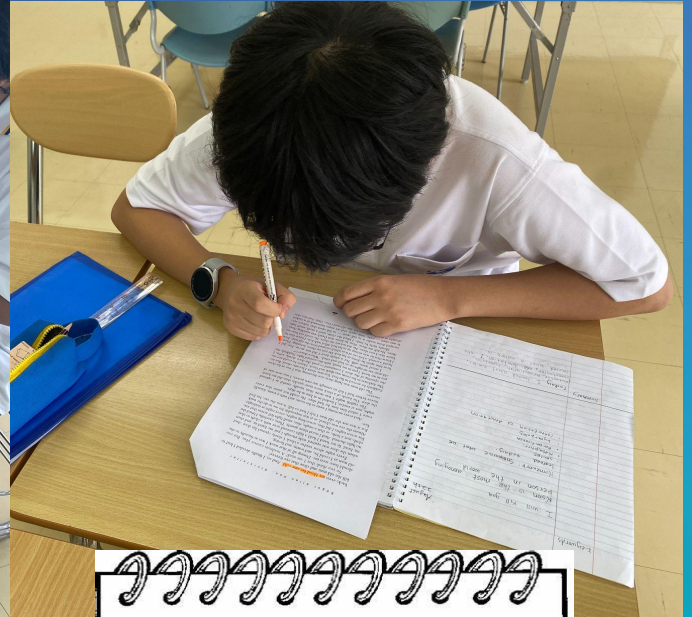

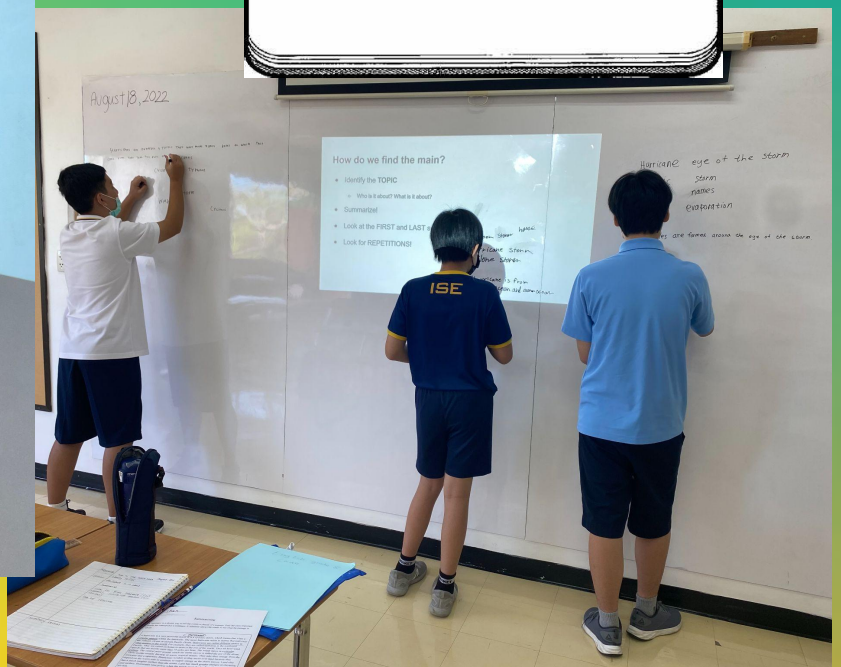
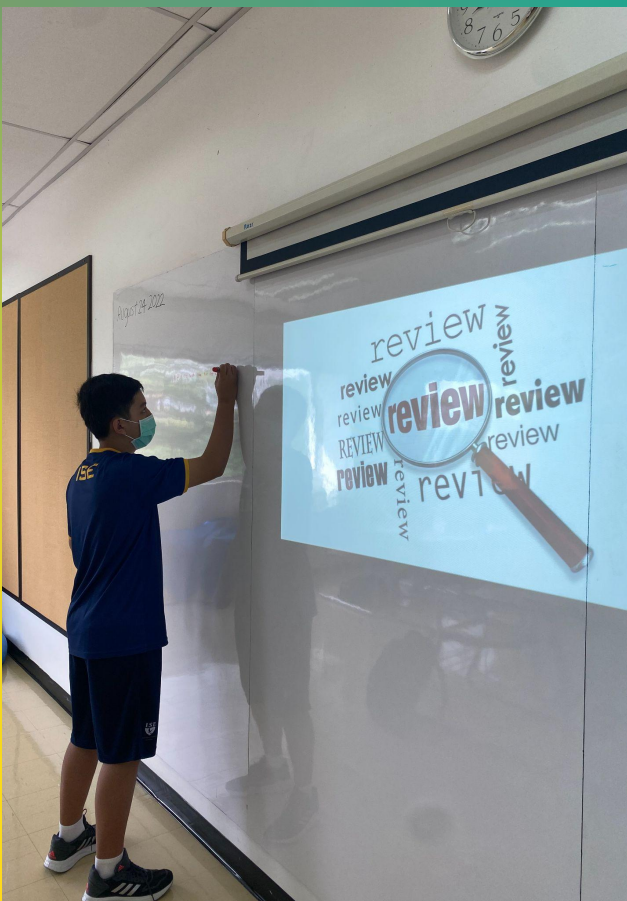

SUMMARY

PURPOSE

The purpose of Chapter Five is to foreshadow Grenouille's imminent sense of isolation due to his devotion to scent.

MADAME GAILLARD

Mme. Gaillarde's death is used to set up a pattern of ironic deaths that continues throughout the book. After losing all her senses by the abuse from her father, her one wish is that she dies in her own home, in private. It is the only thing she still holds on to in life. She is able to buy the house, but unfortunately loses too long. Grenouille invests due to the French revolution for her to sell the house. She dies sometime after, in a hospital surrounded by other sick and dying people.
