Kindergarten had a great first week back at school! We discussed Essential agreements, went on a scavenger hunt around the school, and began our first unit about our identities.



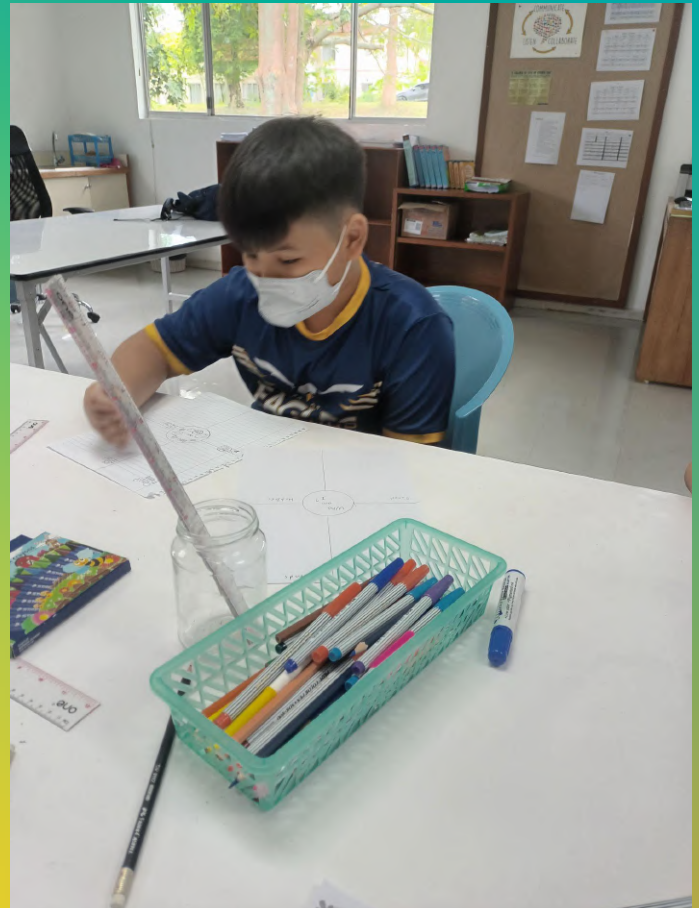
Elementary School G3
