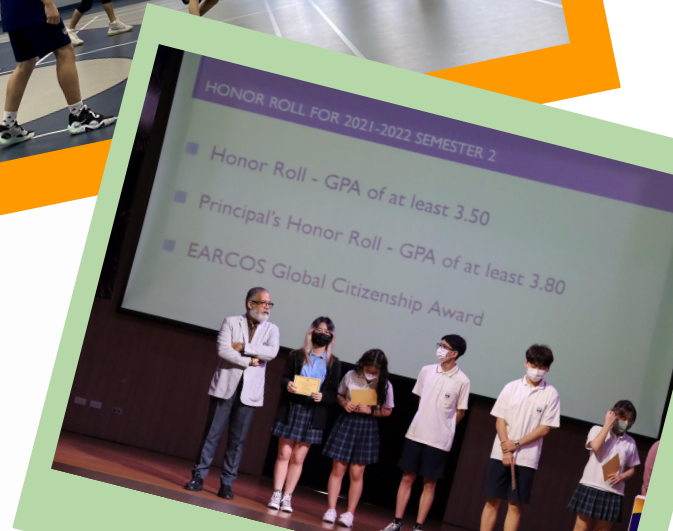
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Oct, 7th

At the same time, Soo Yeon G12's student got an EARCOS Global Citizenship Award 2022.

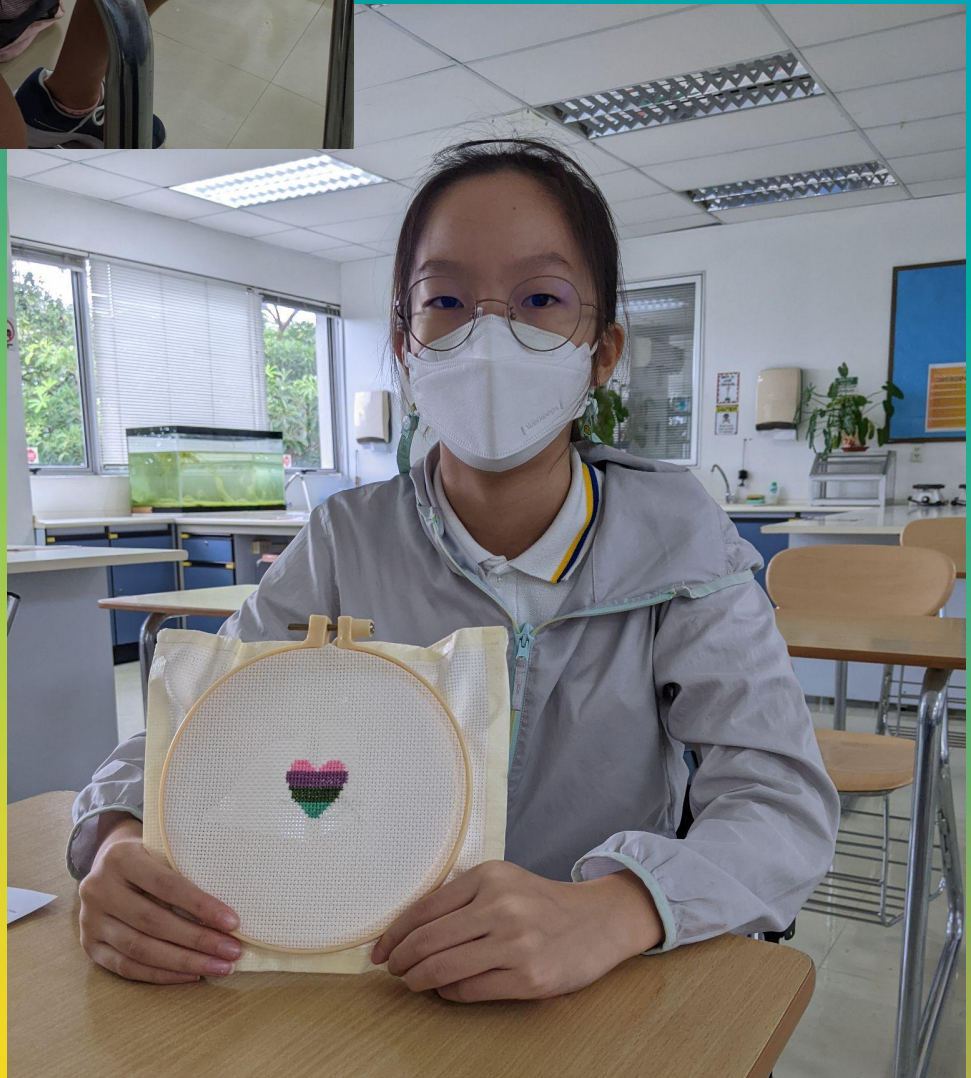
ISE clubs had the opportunity to introduce their work to other students. Operation Smile showed objectives and goals for this year. And NEST talked about their work and their activities during the school year.
