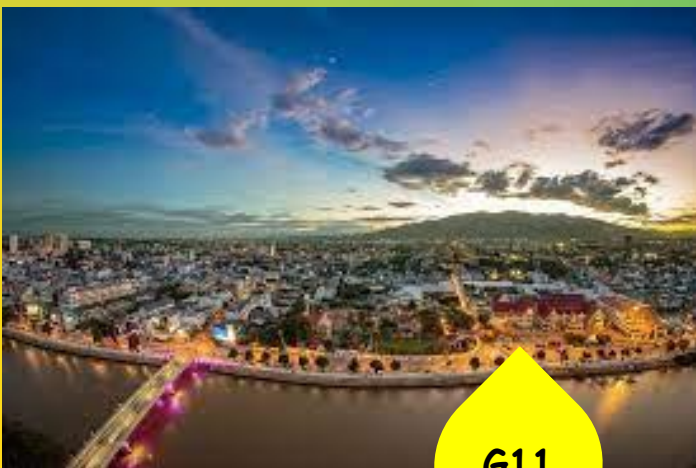

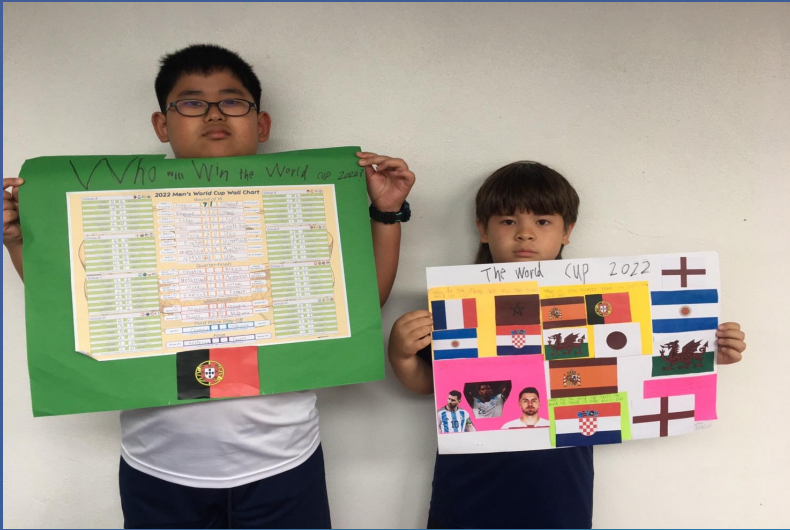
Elementary School G2 & G3



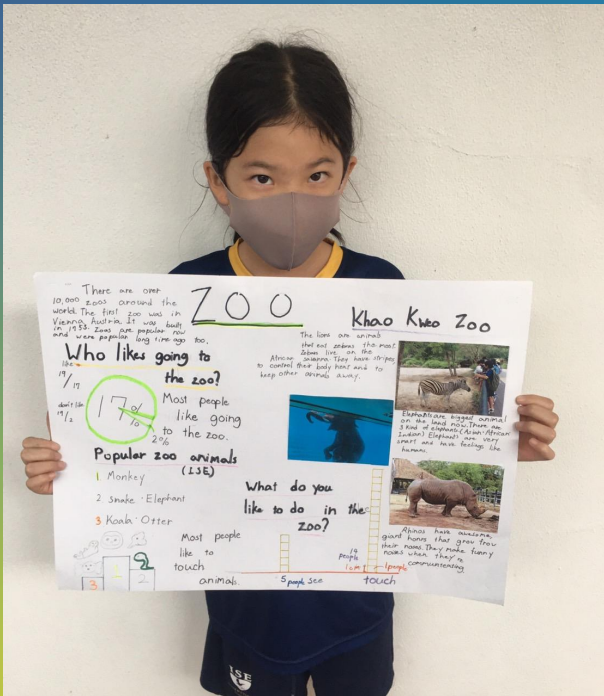

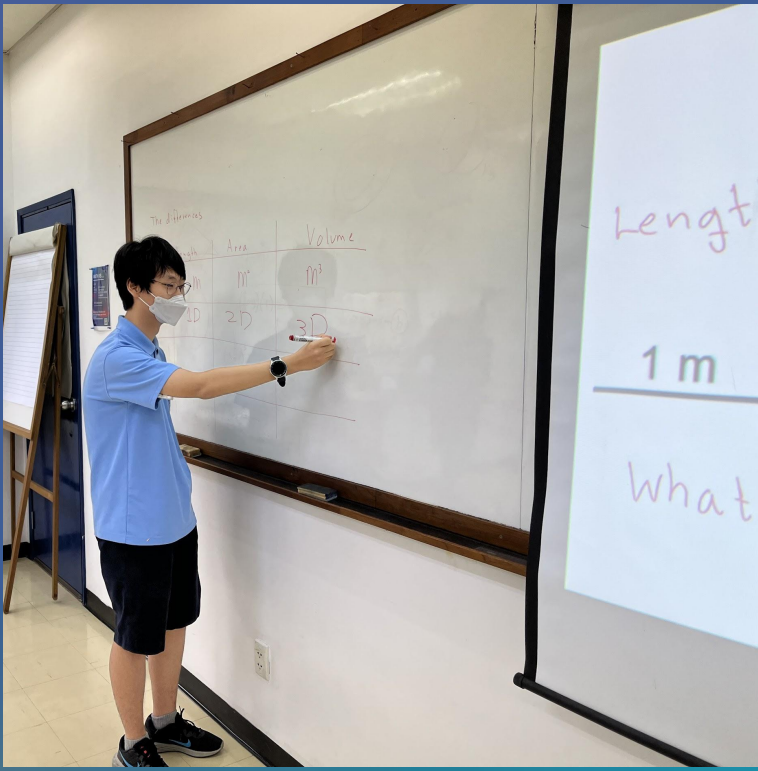
Elementary School EAL G4



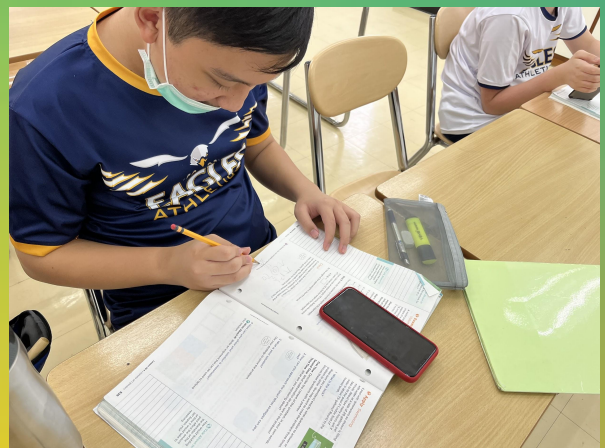
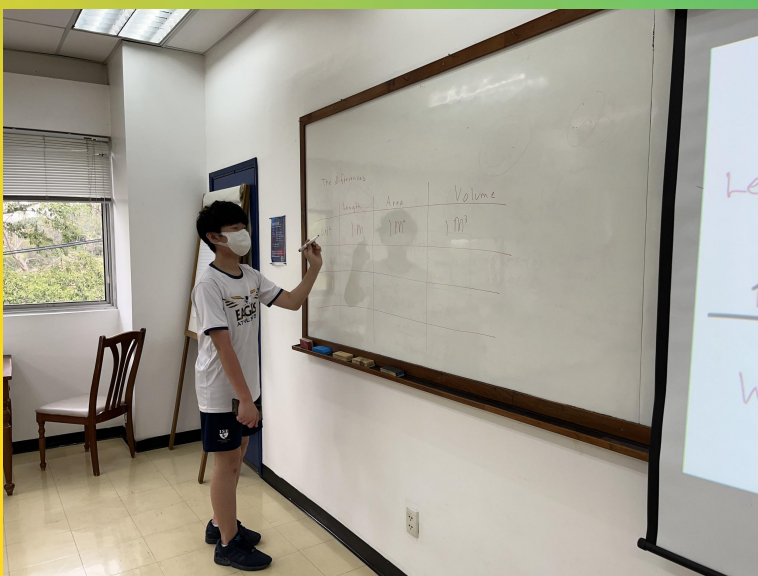

In 8th grade, the students are studying volumes of solids. In this class specifically, they study the differences between length, area and volume and will be able to find volumes of cylinders by the end of the class. For the remaining unit, the students will also learn how to find volumes of cones and spheres which they can use to find volumes of other composite solids. They will also learn how to find missing dimensions of cylinders, cones, and spheres.
