Students, Parents & Teachers Conference



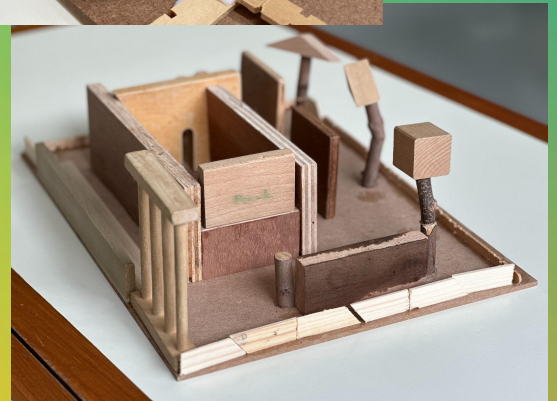
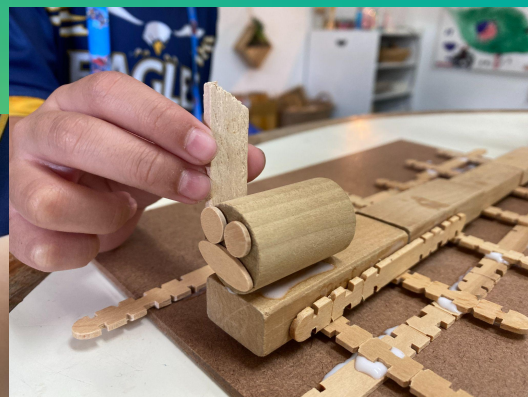

Elementary School Pre-K

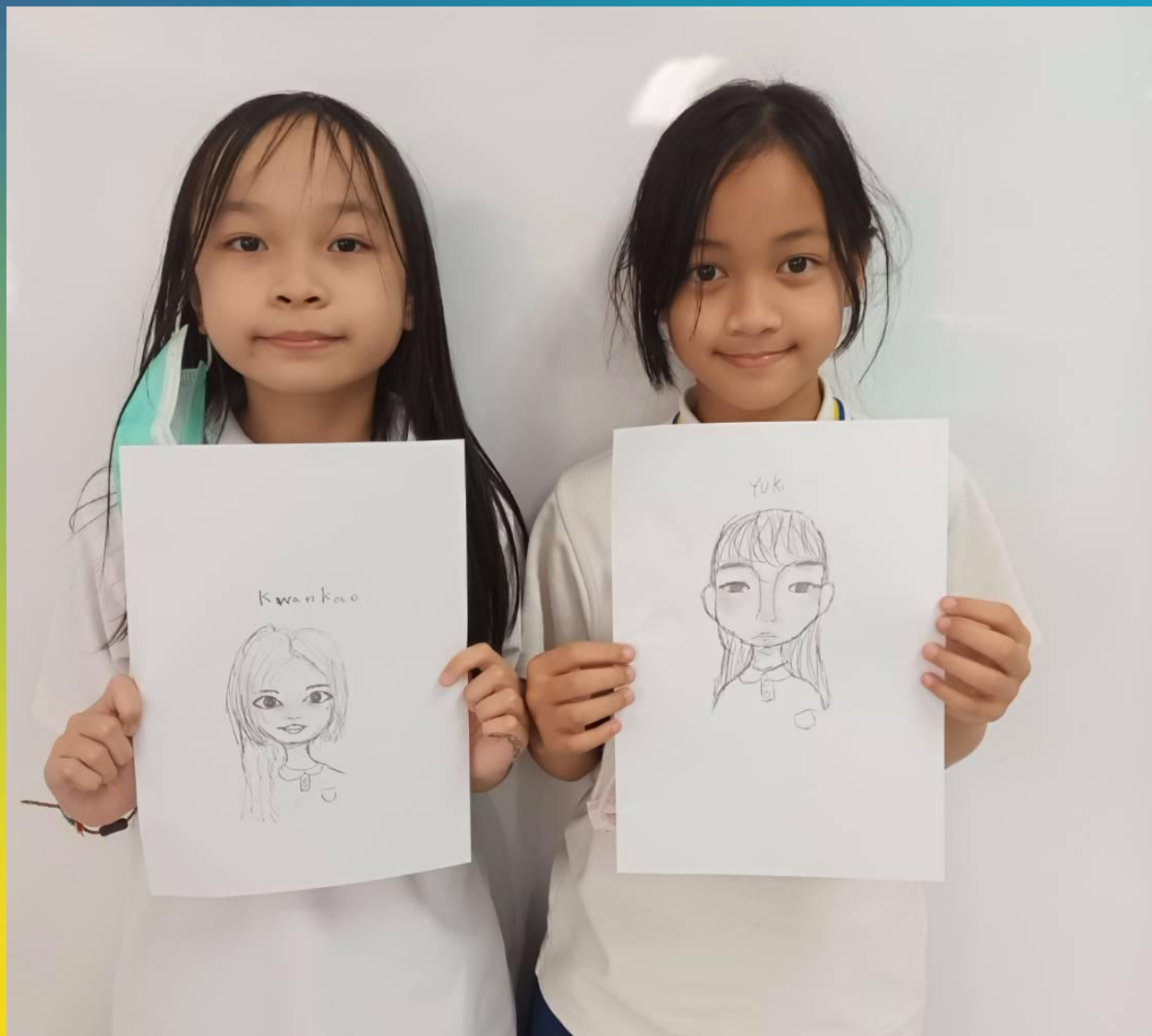

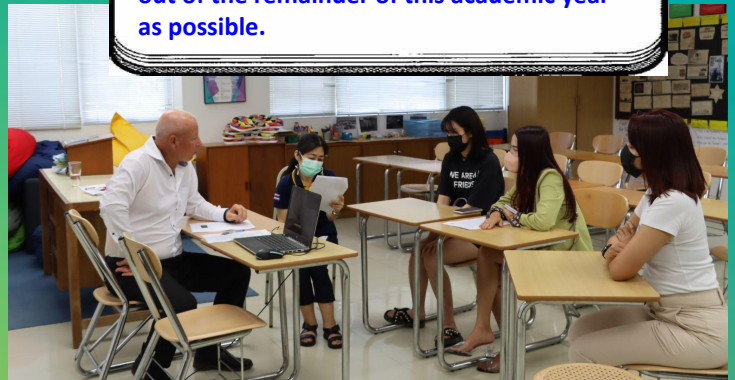
