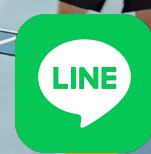

Thank you to all the parents who participated in these meaningful conversations. Your involvement and support play a crucial role in helping our students grow and succeed!



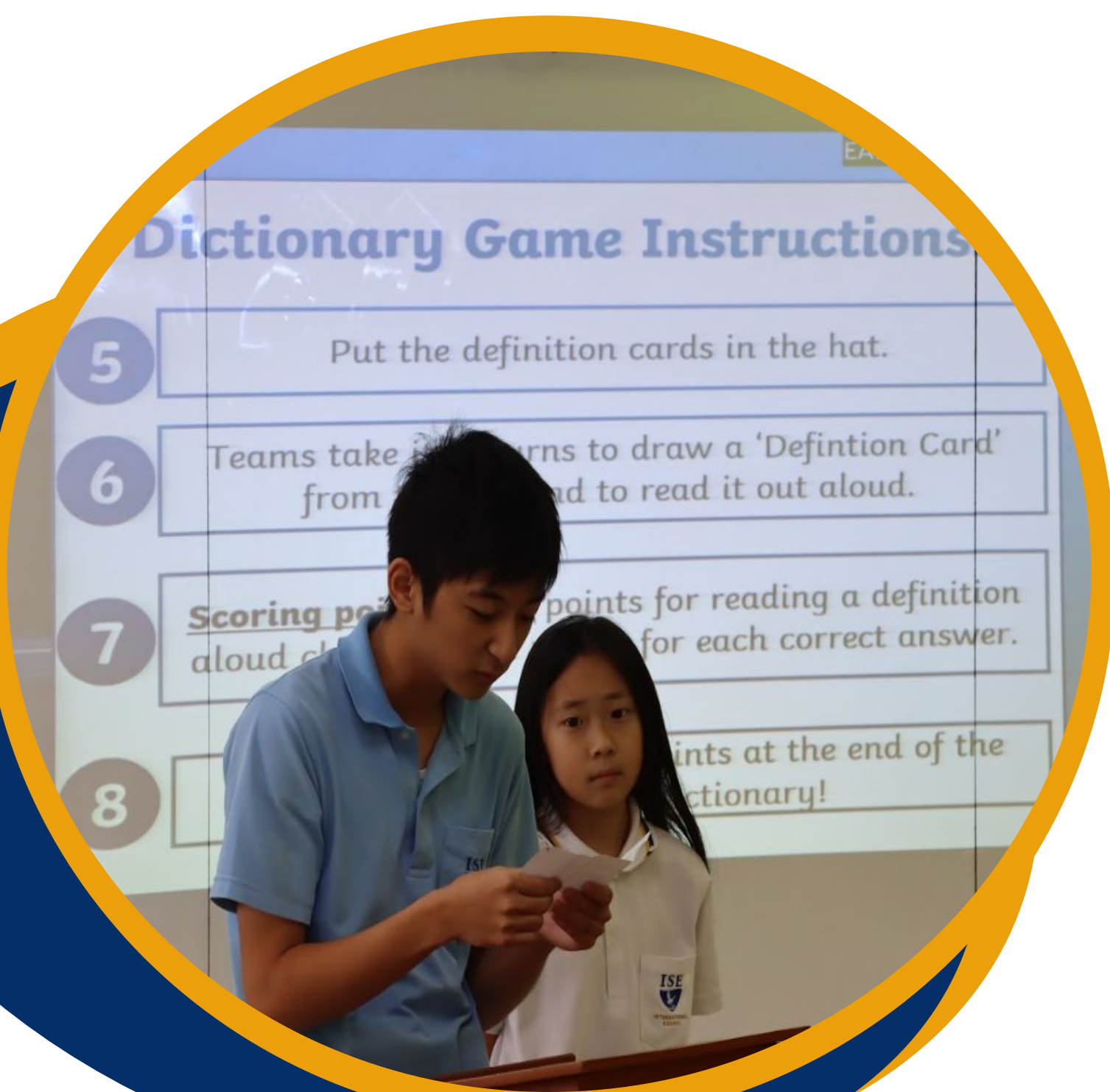


Middle School EAL

Interactive Dictionary Game

In this engaging interactive Dictionary Game, students took an individualized approach to expanding their vocabulary by selecting unfamiliar words from their subject textbooks. They completed definition cards featuring the correct meaning alongside two creative, fake definitions. Working in teams, students read their definitions aloud while others guessed the correct meaning, earning points for accuracy and for correctly guessing each word's definition.

This activity encouraged adventurous learning, challenging students to think critically about language. Through collaboration and strategy, they discovered the power and importance of vocabulary knowledge, making vocabulary building both fun and memorable!
