



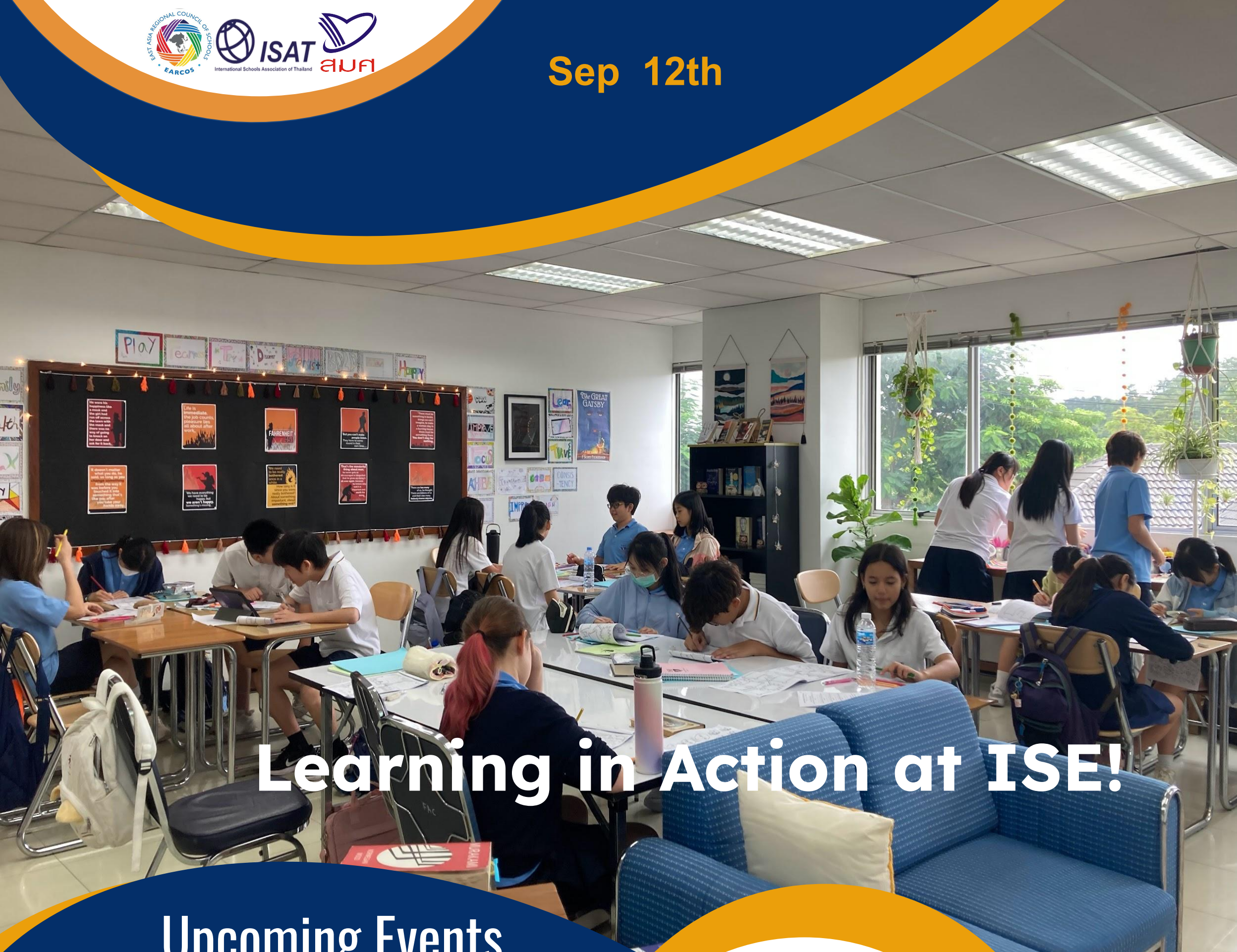

This week in Kindergarten, we have been exploring the exciting world of patterns! Patterns are everywhere around us—from the clothes we wear to the songs we sing—and the children have been having a wonderful time discovering them.

To make learning hands-on and fun, we've been using colorful manipulatives like cubes, counting bears, and even classroom objects to create and extend patterns. The children worked together to build repeating sequences, such as red-blue-red-blue, or bear-cube-bear-cube, and they quickly realized how satisfying it is to see their patterns grow longer and longer.
