Elementary School SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL LEARNING G4&5



 Strong Kids Program

In Grades 4 & 5, students are continuing to grow not only academically, but socially and emotionally as well. Students are receiving lessons from our school counselor, Ms. G, using the Strong Kids curriculum. The recent lesson focused on helping students explore their feelings and understand how those feelings can be expressed in appropriate ways.

They are learning that emotions such as happiness, sadness, anger, frustration, excitement, and worry are a natural part of being human. The goal of these lessons is not to eliminate uncomfortable feelings, but to help students recognize, name, and understand them.

By building these skills, students become better at identifying what they are feeling and why—this helps them with self-control, empathy, and problem solving in their day to day life.





Elementary & Secondary School Thai for Non-Thai KG-G10



Thai Weaving & Basketry Culture

Students from KG to Grade 10 Non-Thai Class learned about Thai weaving and basketry culture in their Thai Studies classes. This unit introduced Thai local wisdom and traditional crafts used in daily life, such as baskets and mats.

Students participated in hands-on paper weaving activities adapted to their age levels. Through this activity, they practiced patience, focus, creativity, and fine motor skills. Older students (Grades 6-10) also wrote short reflections about what they learned, how they felt during the activity,

and why weaving is important to Thai culture.

This unit supports the Thai subject by helping students understand Thai culture and traditions through meaningful, experiential learning.
