In the Grade 4 Japanese class, students worked on an activity titled “Let’s Create a Map of Japan Using Paper Cups.” Based on what they had learned about Japan’s geography and the kanji for each prefecture, they created a large map of Japan using paper cups.

By recalling the locations of each prefecture and carefully deciding where to place them, students deepened their understanding of the map of Japan. In addition, through working collaboratively with their peers, they developed their ability to apply and express their learning and apply what they had learned in an enjoyable and meaningful way.
