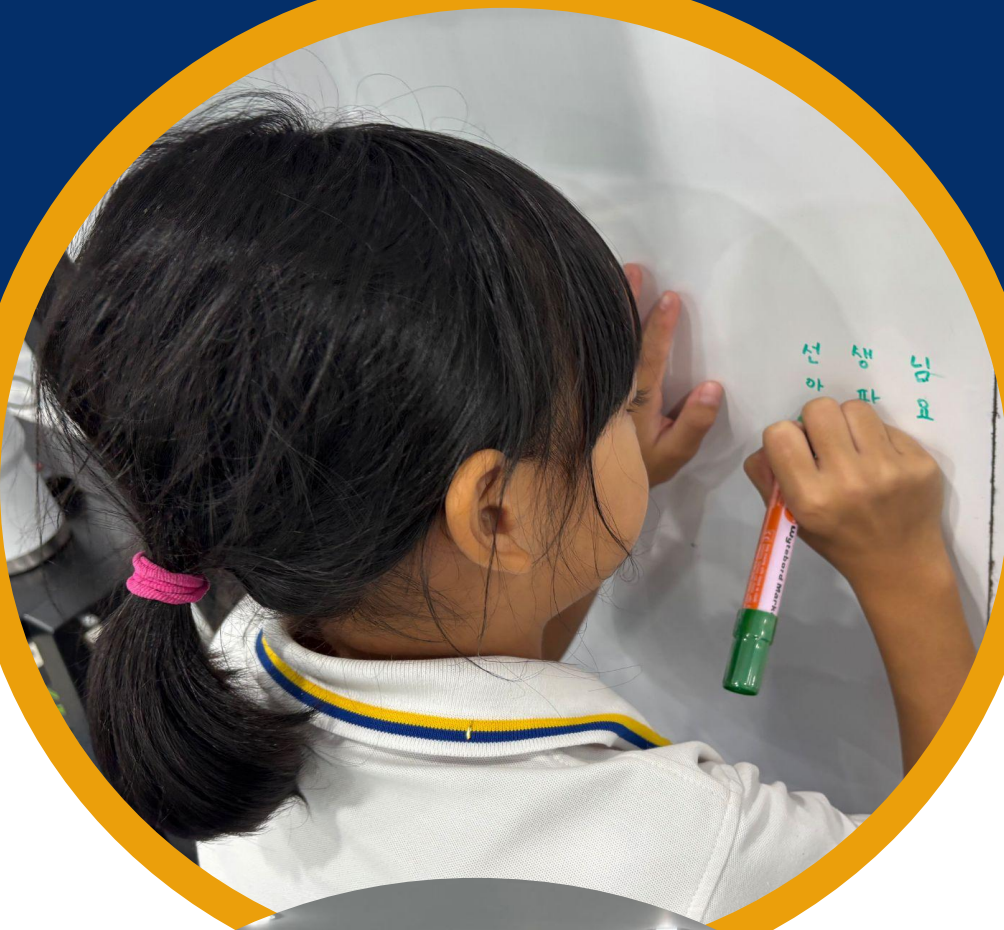

## Secondary School BIOLOGY G6



### Investigating Thermal Energy Transfer Through Specific Heat Capacity Experiments

Sixth grade students conducted a hands-on laboratory investigation to explore how different metals absorb and transfer thermal energy.

During the activity, students examined the specific heat capacities of various metals, including aluminum, steel, and lead. Using calorimeters and precise temperature measurements, they collected quantitative data and analyzed how different materials respond to thermal energy.

Students applied scientific reasoning to compare their experimental results with established reference values and critically evaluated possible sources of experimental error. This inquiry-based activity strengthened their laboratory skills, data analysis abilities, and critical-thinking skills while deepening their understanding of energy transfer and the physical properties of matter."

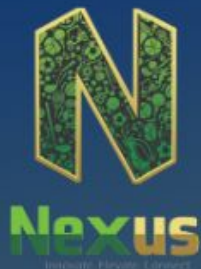

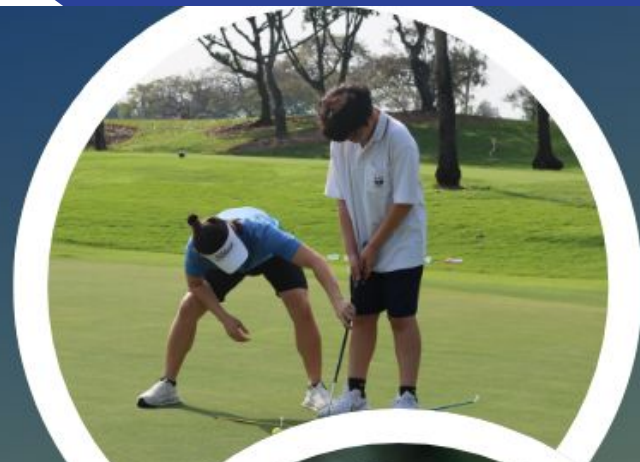
