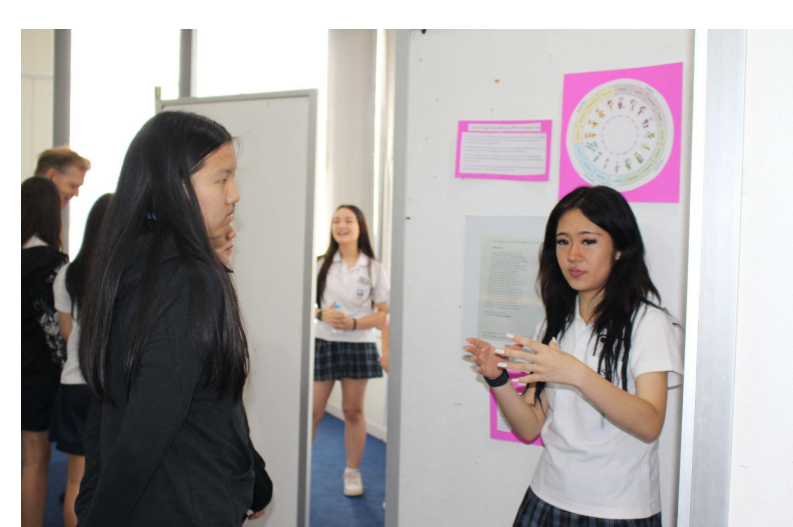
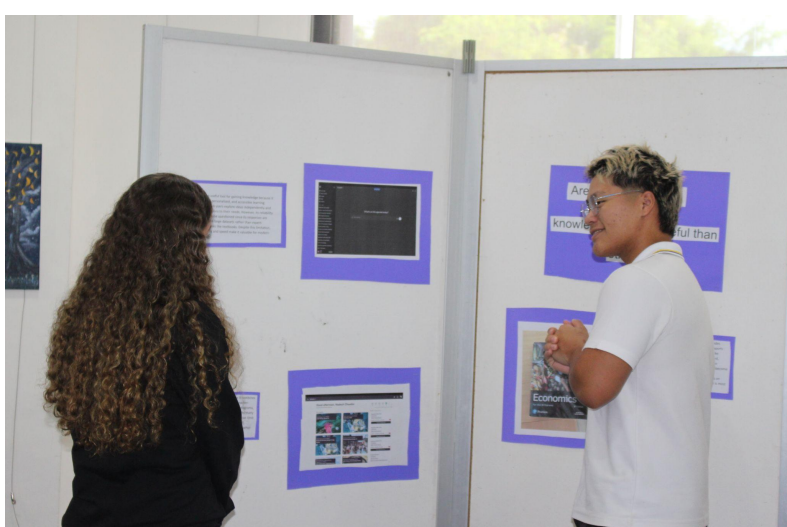

It was a fantastic turnout, providing a wonderful opportunity for our students to observe what they will soon undertake in the next few years. The exhibition is a core component of the IB program, challenging students to select one of 35 philosophical prompts and explore it through three specific, real-world objects. From family heirlooms to scientific instruments, our students demonstrated remarkable sophistication in linking these items to complex questions about how we acquire, validate, and share knowledge. 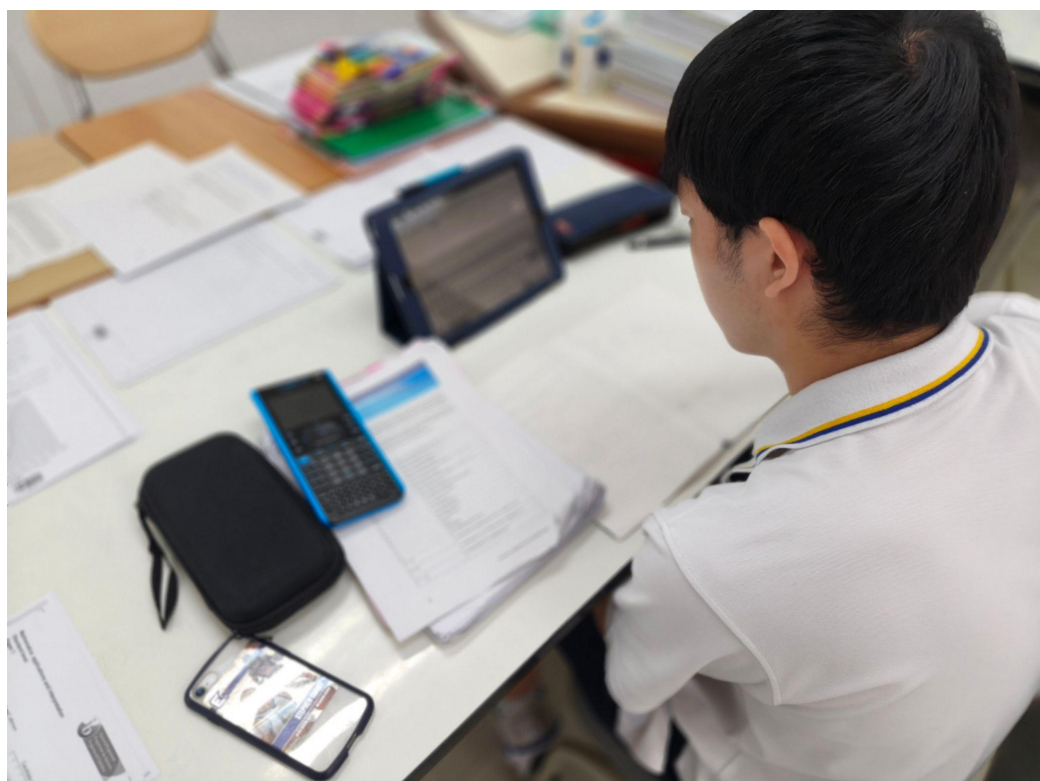
## Secondary School IBDP MATH G11



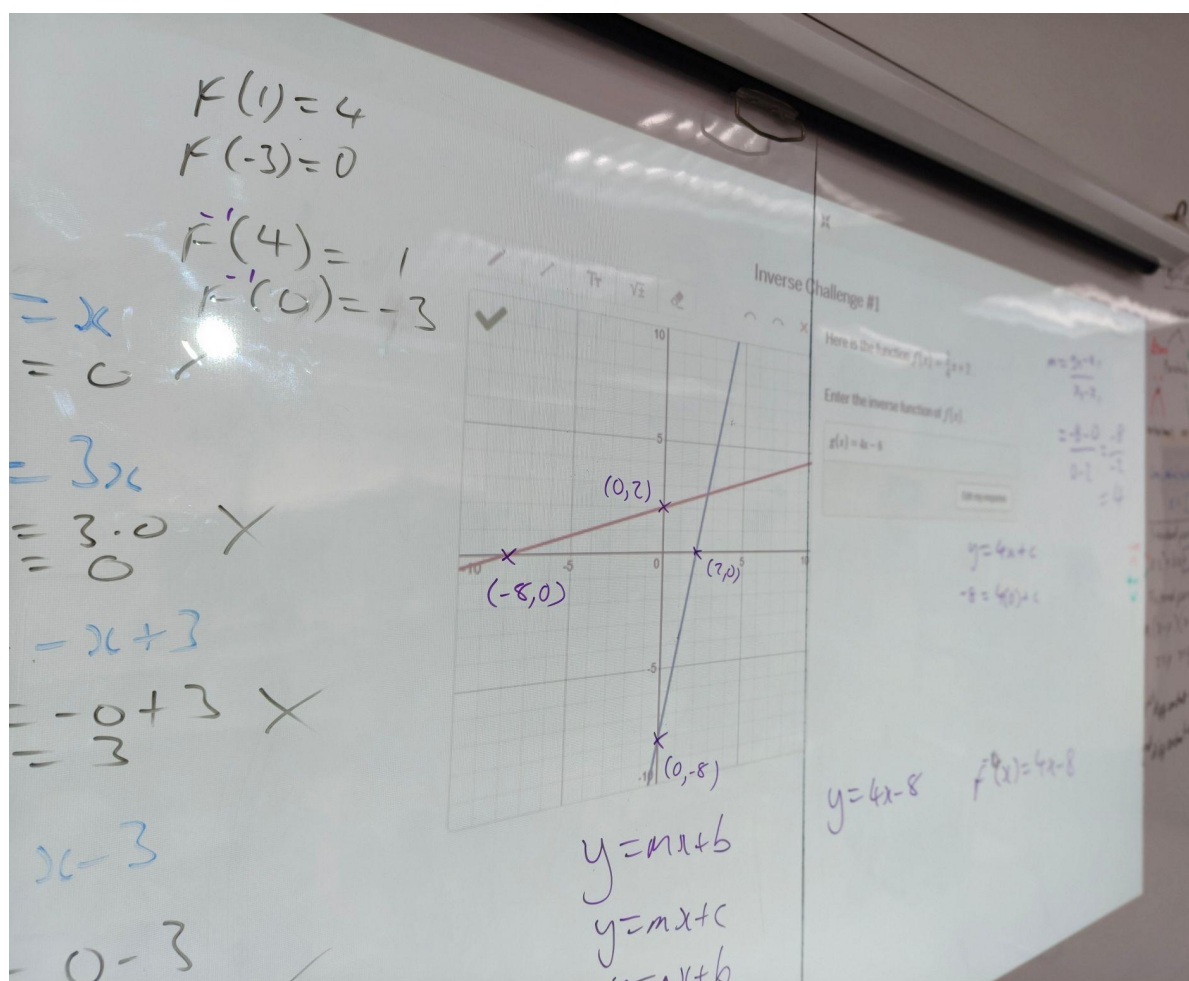
### Grade 11 IBDP Mathematics: Applications and Interpretation

Students investigated graphing different linear functions to determine which functions are inverses of each other.

They also looked at what properties are important in this respect, and used their graphing calculators and Desmos Amplify to analyze these functions and properties.



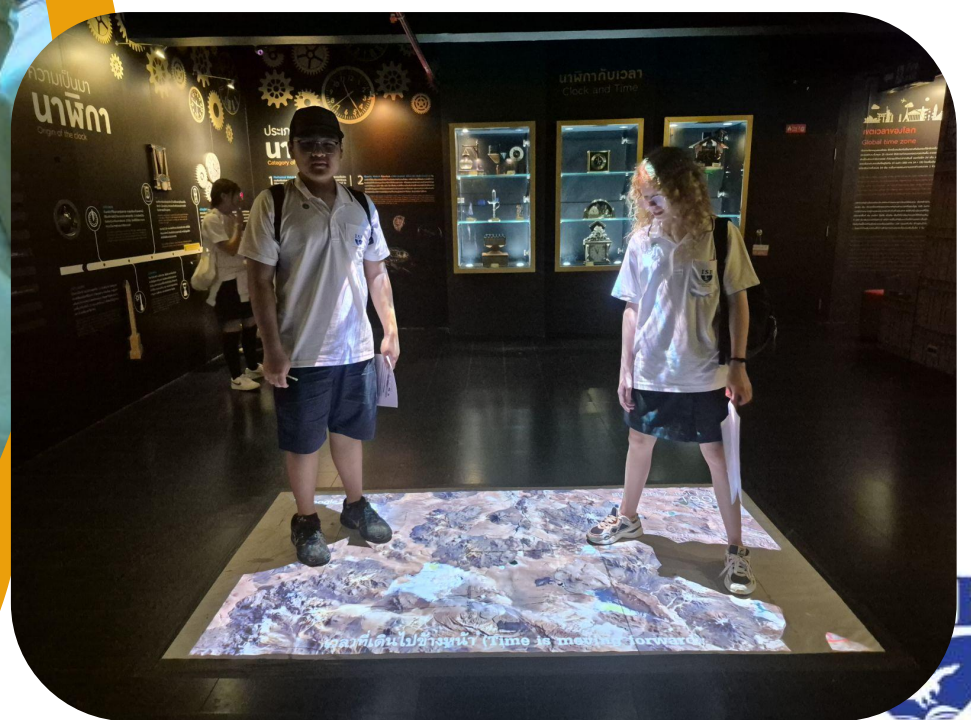
Finally, they looked at an exam question involving a non-linear function in order to use the skills and knowledge learned from linear functions in an unfamiliar and real-life context.

On May 12, our Grade 6 and 8 students headed to the National Science Centre for Education (Bangkok) for a day of immersive discovery. The students explored a wide range of interactive exhibits covering space technology, prehistoric life, and the physics of energy.
