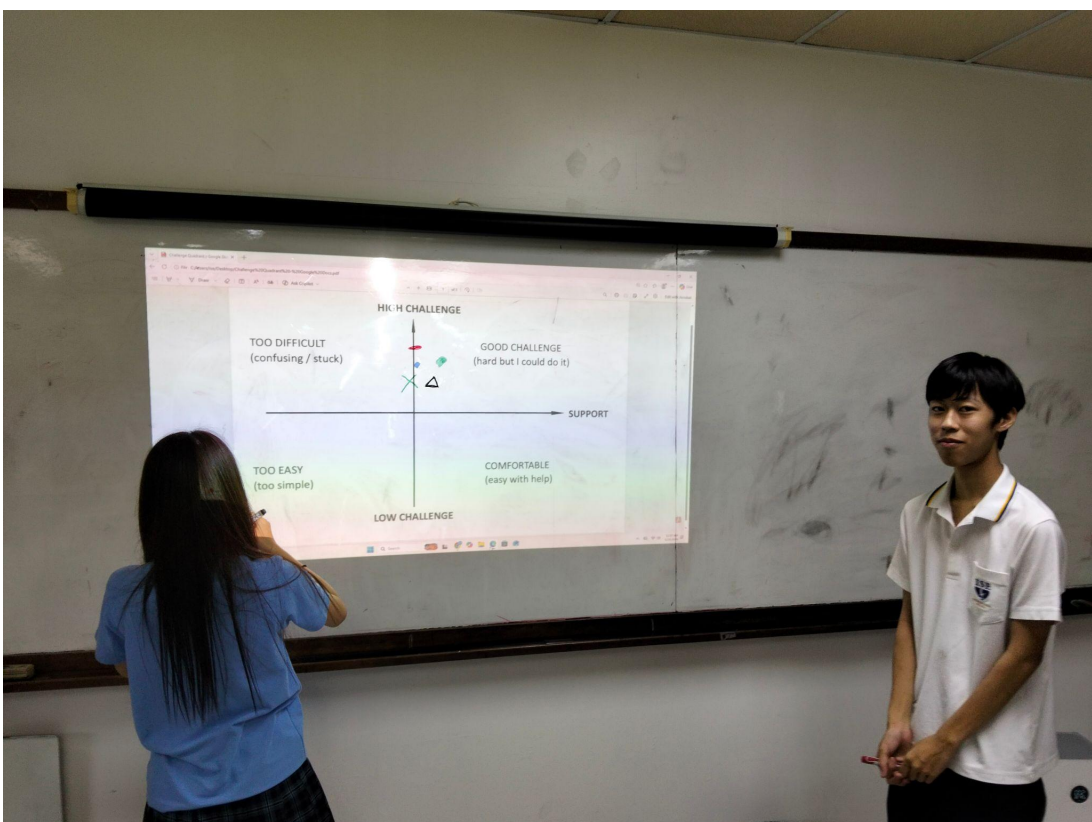
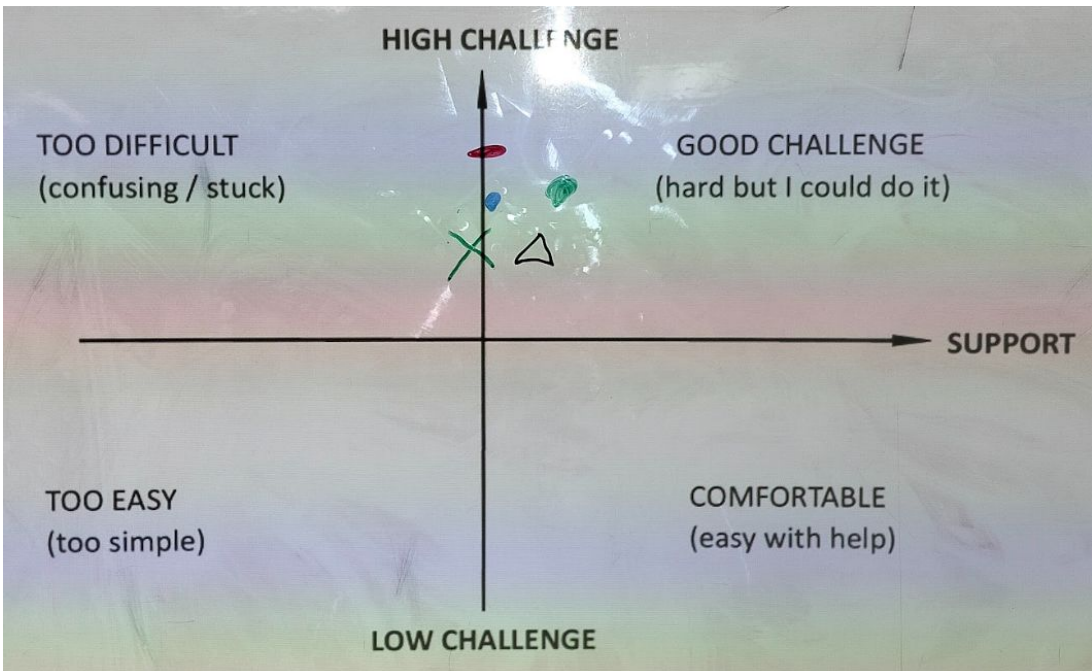
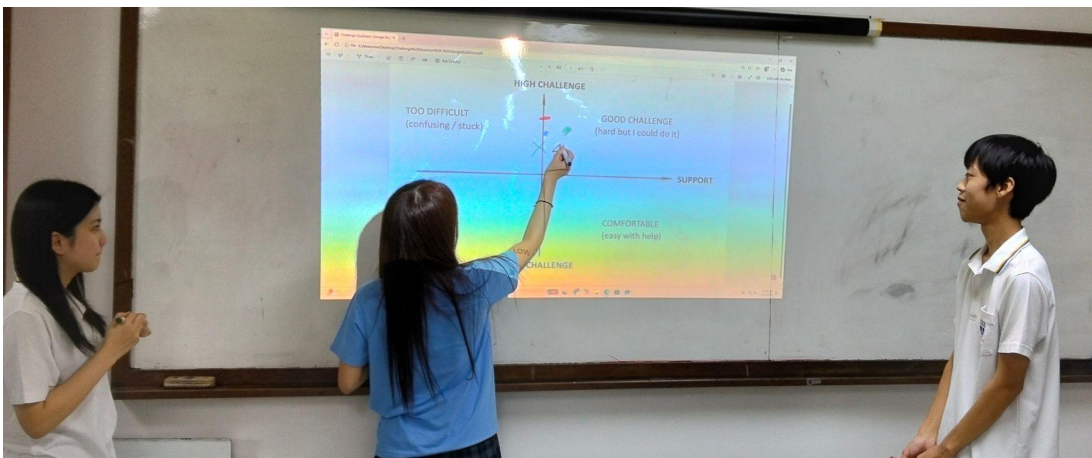

SECONDARY EAL Student-led Discussion



Our student-led discussion groups dived deep into authentic global sustainability issues, turning the classroom into a hub for debate. To find the ultimate "sweet spot" of learning, we used Mariani's Challenge-Support Quadrant as a tool for student self-assessment and direct student-to-teacher feedback.

By stepping up to the board and plotting experiences with the completed task, learners evaluated their own progress in real-time. This visual shows us exactly how close our discussion groups came to a "Good Challenge" within the Zone of Proximal Development (ZPD), a space where our limits are stretched, but where we ultimately succeed. This also helped us see where we thrived and where we need to fine-tune our classroom support systems for our next group discussion. It is a fantastic, collaborative way for us to co-create an environment where every single learner can thrive!

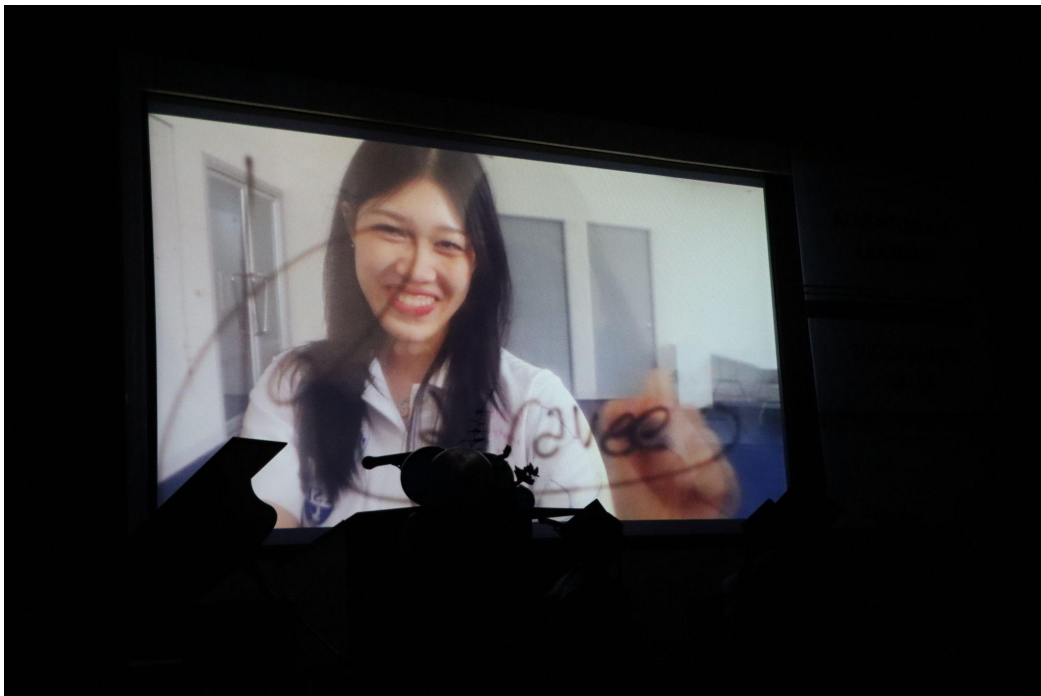

Rayong Field Trip

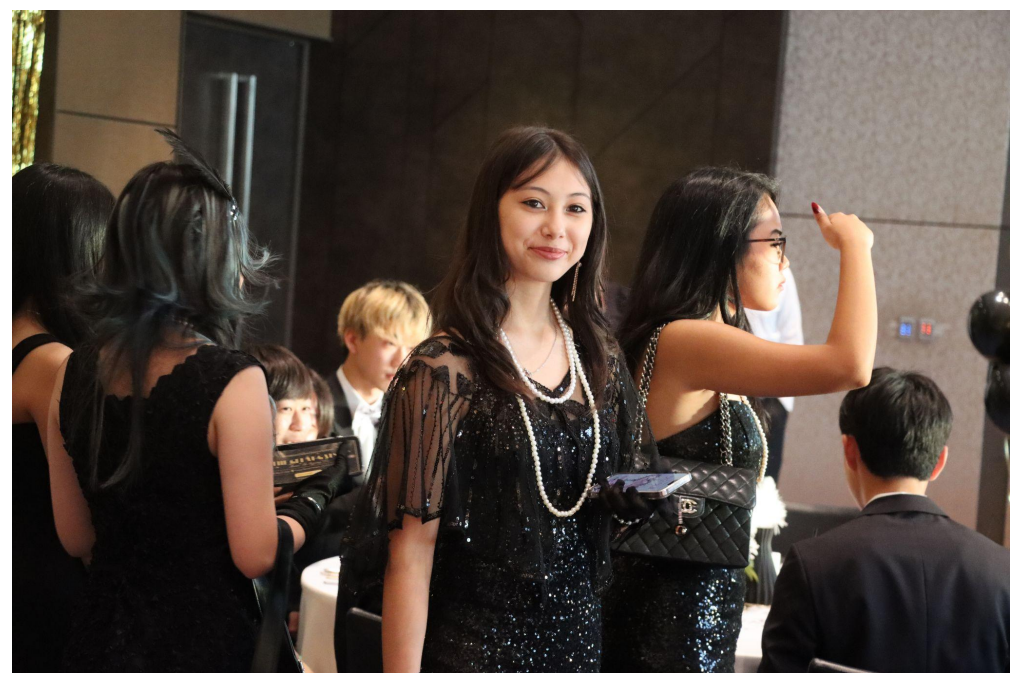
